How we collect the information about you

We collect information during incidents we attend and this includes personal data. This information is recorded in an electronic system known as the IRS.

Why we are collecting your information

IRS data is collected by us on behalf of the Home Office for research and statistical purposes only. We also use this data for our own statistical and research purposes which enables us to understand risk and demand to allocate resources accordingly.

What information is being collected?

The information collected relates to the incidents attended by a us and includes the following;

- Contact details (including business information)
- Location information
- Victim information (name, age, gender, medical provision)
- Ethnicity
- Vehicle registration details

How we will use your information

We are collecting your information to help us understand better the role and demand on us and inform fire policy and future service provision.

Data subject category

Members of the public, businesses and other parties.





Legal basis for the processing

Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest to meet a function of the Crown, a minister of the Crown or a government department. The information is also used for statistical and research purposes.

Who we share your information with

IRS data is primarily shared with the Home Office and other bodies.

How long we hold your information for

Personal data collected will be held for up to 70 years.
