## REPORT OF CHAIR

#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. To provide feedback to members on the recent Combined Fire Authority (CFA) Conference held on 12 October 2017.

# **BACKGROUND**

- 2. Members have agreed to feedback a summary of any key issues emerging from conferences, events or seminars they have attended on behalf of the Authority.
- 3. The CFA Conference is held annually at Wyboston Lakes in Bedfordshire. This year's conference covered a number of key issues including: an update from the Home Office on progress with the Policing and Crime Act 2017; the Inspection Process for Fire and Rescue Services; Fire Funding Policy; Mental Health implications for employers; Buckinghamshire Fire and Rescue Service's approach to workforce reform; the Retained Duty System (RDS) workstream from the National Fire Chiefs Council (NFCC); and a collaboration on risk management and protection.
- 4. The Chair, the Chief Fire Officer and the Workforce Development Manager, Katherine Metcalfe delivered a presentation on the apprenticeship scheme the Service have introduced and the lessons learned from this process.
